

GRADE BASIS - LETTER GRADE (L), PASS/FAIL (P) OR AUDIT (A)

Grade Basis (or Grade Mode) Explanation:

Many classes at GT are offered as letter grade (L), pass/fail (P) or audit (A). All classes used for your BSME or BSNRE must be taken as letter grade. Students who take additional classes are able to take classes pass/fail or audit mode, if the class is available with that Grade Basis (or Grade Mode). You can view the grade basis (or grade mode) for each class using the following instructions:

1. Log into Buzzport, www.buzzport.gatech.edu.
2. Select [Registration - OSCAR](#) to log into OSCAR.
3. Select [Student Services & Financial Aid](#).
4. Select [Registration](#).
5. Select [Look Up Classes](#).
6. Select the [Term](#) and press [Submit](#).
7. Select the subject you are interested in and press [Course Search](#).
8. Select the class number and press [View Sections](#).
9. On the [Look-Up Classes to Add](#) screen, the [Bas](#) column shows the grade basis for each class.

Using the screen shot below, you can see that INTA 2030 is offered as letter grade (L) or pass/fail (P).

Look-Up Classes to Add:

To register for classes, check the box in front of the CRN and click Register or Add to Worksheet. Both where you can continue with the registration process.

The letter "C" to the left of a class means that the class is closed. "SR" means you cannot register for the class due to restrictions on the course OR your time. "NR" means not available for registration. NOTE: If you are not eligible to register for a class, you will not be able to add class.

The column labeled "BAS" is the grade basis for the class. "A" = audit, "L" = letter grade, and "P" = pass/fail. Click the CRN of the course to see the registration process. Registration will close at the time of hours for a variable hour course. Once registration closes, you cannot add class, co-op work assignment, and any drop.
